

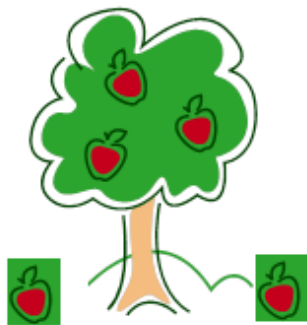
## 2. Reason Abstractly and Quantitatively.

### Decontextualize

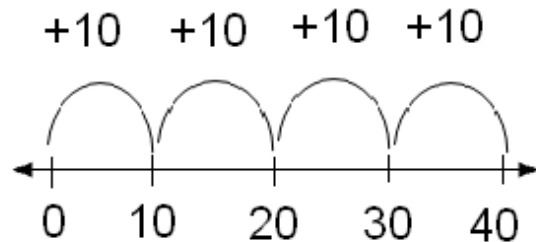
take quantities out of context to work with them

### Contextualize

put quantities into context to see if they make sense
